Standardized Testing Day

Reminder to all students that **Wednesday**, **Oct. 12th**, is Standardized Testing Day.

On this day, 9th graders will be taking the PSAT 8/9, 10th & 11th graders will be taking the PSAT, and 12th graders (who

Healthy Tip of the Week!

Did you know 1.3 BILLION TONS of food are wasted globally each year? Here's one effort towards reducing that waste:

When you've got fresh fruit on its last days, freeze it using the "IQF" (individually quick frozen) method:

- Slice it up
- Spread the pieces evenly on a parchment-lined sheet
- Freeze
- After completely frozen, transfer the pieces to a container.
- Use frozen fruit in smoothies, or cook them to serve with breakfast or dessert.
