# Healthy Tip of the Week!

#### \*\*Easy Pre-Dinner Snack!\*\*

Sweet Potato Wedges with Maple Butter: Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Cut 2 medium sweet potatoes into wedges. Toss the wedges with 1 tablespoon of avocado oil and a pinch of sea salt. Arrange them evenly without overlapping across a parchment-lined bak-

ing sheet and bake for 20 minutes, turning over halfway through. Remove from oven and cool for a few minutes. While sweet potatoes cool, place 2 tablespoons unsalted butter and 2 tablespoons pure maple syrup in a microwave-safe bowl. Heat in microwave for 20-30 seconds, or until butter is melted. Stir in <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon ground cinnamon, a pinch of sea salt and a dash of cayenne pepper (optional). Dip wedges in maple butter & enjoy!
