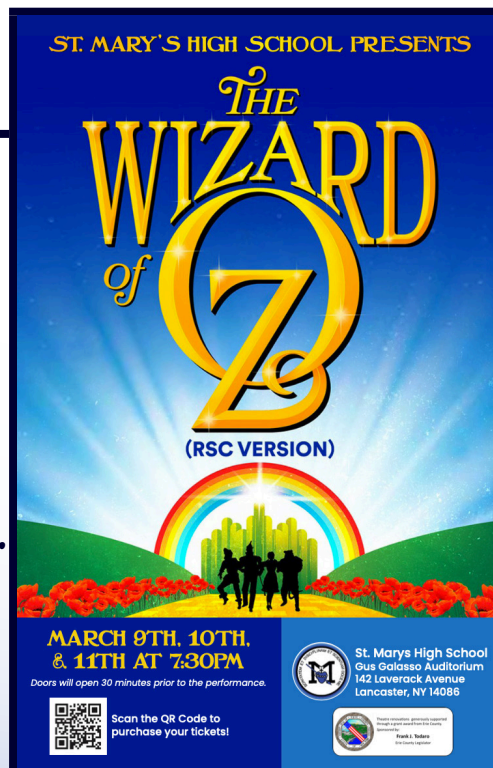

Pizzas are preferred!

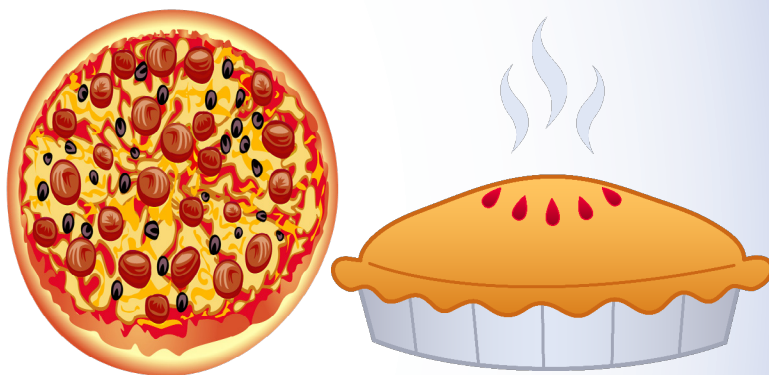
All pizzas/pies must be handed in on 3/14/2023 by 8 am in the cafeteria.
